Recent reports in the press and social media have depicted certain areas of abuse and cruelty in the Mohair Industry. While we acknowledge that some of the behaviours reported on are unacceptable and a shocking exception, we do not believe that this in any way represents normal farming practice in the industry.

We at SAMIL Natural Fibres vehemently condemn any mistreatment of animals, in the industry or otherwise, and as members of South African Wool and Mohair Buyers Association, who have representation at Mohair South Africa, strongly support the current investigation, and the action taken against the alleged farms.
